A **heat wave** that has scorched southern Australia, causing transport chaos by buckling rail lines and leaving more than 140,000 homes without power, is a sign of climate change, the government said Thursday.

The Bureau of Meteorology is forecasting six days of more than 40-degree-Celsius (104 Fahrenheit) temperatures for southern Australia, potentially the worst heat wave in 100 years.

Australia is one of the nations most vulnerable to climate change due to its hot, dry climate and is already gripped by drought. Fire bans have been declared in southern Australia to prevent major bush fires, although small fires are already burning.
